

Born in 1848 to self-emancipated Virginians, Lewis Howard Latimer was a Black **inventor** who combined his love of art and science to improve life for others.

Without access to formal education, Lewis Latimer taught himself how to draw and became a **chief draftsman**, **patent expert**, and **inventor**. He worked with inventors like Alexander Graham Bell, Hiram Maxim, and Thomas Edison, and made many improvements to the process of creating the lightbulb that made **electric lighting more affordable**.
